

Announcement – Paid Cooking Opportunity

The Idaho Office for Refugees in partnership with the Idaho Museum of International Diaspora, is offering paid cooking opportunities for talented home cooks and trained chefs from refugee and immigrant backgrounds. This is a great opportunity to share your culture through food, practice public speaking skills and introduce yourself to new audiences! These will take place every other month in 2024 beginning in January.

<u>Goal:</u> Connect and inspire through food! Enlighten local audiences to new cultures. Increase awareness about the refugee community's cultural diversity in Boise. Make new friends!

When: January 11th, 2024

Total Time Commitment: 5-7 hours depending on recipe, method, and skill.

Event Time: 5-6pm (set-up) 6:00-7:30pm (event) 7:30-8:30pm (clean-up)

Where: JUMP 1000 W Myrtle St, Boise, ID 83702

<u>Pay:</u> \$250 for 1 home cook, \$100 for support (friend or family member) OR \$350 for a trained chef. At least 1 JUMP and 2 IOR staff members will be on hand to support. **IOR will cover the cost of the materials and JUMP will provide all cooking tools in their professional grade kitchen!**

Requirements:

- From a refugee or immigrant background
- Comfortable speaking in English in front of an audience
- Desire to connect with and educate other Idahoans through this event
- Produce a written recipe for the featured dish(s) at least two weeks before the event
- Produce an ingredients list at least two weeks prior to the event
